

TRANSCRIPT OF MEETING OF CURRICULUM REVIEW TEAM

Following wider consultations with students, construction industry representatives, professors and other stakeholders according to Article 13 of the Regulation and procedure of development/review and approval of new curricula of College ESLG, the Curriculum Development Team for the study master program Law and Management of Real Estate and Infrastructure (BA) proposes the following:

- 1. The study program's mission is in full accordance with the mission of the institution;
- 2. Program's goals, objectives and leaning outcomes are fully in accordance with the needs of the labour market, and future trends of the Kosovo and regional labour market development and the employability of graduates of such a profile as required by Article 11 of the present Regulation. The link with the labour market and contribution of the program to the private sector can also be seen in the Three Year Review of the Department of Real Estate, where construction industry representatives provide their findings regarding the contribution to the private sector and link with the labour market;
- 3. The study program has sufficient professors with full time status and part time status whereby most of ECTS credits are covered by full time staff. Also, joining the UBT group makes the program has access to a very long list of professors from UBT College. The professor with the highest academic title is Associate professor, which is sufficient to deliver the master program according to international standards. The program also possesses 2 main bearers of the program as required by Administrative Instruction of MEST. The study program fulfills all staff requirements as required by Article 7 of the present Regulation.
- 4. The study program was in implementation since 2010 (first accredited until 2016 and then validated as a program with diploma issued by Nova Univerza in Slovenia) and has plenty of physical books and electronic literature sufficient for the implementation of the program.
